2. Quotations for proposed works

Twickenham

The quotations received from all bidders for the work to replace the plastic awning outside the Miller Hall and for enclosing the space to the side of Miller Hall were all considered too expensive and the projects have been postponed. It is proposed to seek alternative methods of undertaking the requirements.

Of the quotations received for the refurbishment of the Honey Prep Room, it was agreed to move forward with the quotation from NicoBuild, which offered the most detail in terms of actual materials to be used and Value for Money, subject to final clarification on requirements. (Post meeting note – NicoBuild have revisited and are going to requote on the revised requirements.)

It is envisaged the work will start late June taking approximately 2-3 weeks.

3. Mole Works

Work has been completed on the replacement of the gates. Final invoice to follow. A considerable amount of work has been done in replacing the fencing at Mole by Alex Lawrence to the tune of £716.55 inc vat. After a formal vote, with the Hon Treasurer abstaining, the Committee reluctantly agreed payment of the amount without any formal receipts for the work. It was agreed that in future any such amounts would not be paid without receipts.

4. Treasurers update

The draft Report and Accounts 2016 have been finalised but as it is not possible to have another committee meeting before the AGM, Neil Hilbery proposed and the committee agreed that the draft should be circulated to committee members for consideration and to state whether or not the draft was acceptable.
