## 1. Minutes and Outstanding issues from last meeting

No amendments required, Minutes accepted as read. Ted proposed, Candy seconded. Outstanding issues:

- a. Newbury visit went very well, six visitors were hosted royally. Candy was interested in how the apiary at Newbury was run. They used a P.A system using a wireless headset and boombox. This was used at inspections for beginners groups and education trips. Email sent by Candy thanking the Association.
- b. Open Day on 2<sup>nd</sup> June: There was good attendance. This was the first year without the imput of Malcolm and Julia and everything went smoothly.
- c. Prototype for new sign: Work has been done to amend the wording (Claire Toberty)

### 2. Apiary and Mole works

- a. Work outside Margaret English, rear of Miller Hall is due to finish. The downpipe goes into a waterbutt which is regularly emptied. Although the 3 inch pipe is connected to a 1 inch pipe, only exceptionally heavy rain would be a problem and the overflow pipe also connects to the waterbutt.
- b. **Hide**: The measurements of the new hide are bound by a tree and the boundary fence. Candy pointed out that the hide could be wider taking 1 metre from the apiary space, ie compromise on dimensions as there have been 3-4 stings this season alone compared with 3 in the last decade. Alex suggests extending poles at rear, rafters, cover in plywood and coated steel then guttering around it. The new structure will be needed by November so the necessary adjustments can be made to the fabric. Patrick suggests Alex's design to be sent to the Education group to review feedback and make a decision at the next meeting. The cost of £1500 does not include erection of the structure. Patrick to find out the cost of erection.
- c. **Mole Apiary:** Harvey has spoken to Ray regarding replacement of the shed with same dimensions. Harvey to provide costings for a 6' x8' shed and slabs for foundations for next meeting. Windows in the main building need replacing but are not leaking. The kitchen area is damp so there is a possibility of a leak. The guttering also needs attention. Some repairs of the corrugated roof have also been carried out to make good.
