#### 1. Minutes and Matters Arising

#### Mole:

### **Twickenham Apiary:**

- 1. Solars in the apiary are not in a useful place, ideally they should face south, angle 56 degrees, to look at relocating solar and trimming trees so it has more direct sunlight.
- 2. Colonies in the apiary: 9 colonies, 5 nucs some of these were caste swarms and may be queenless.
- 3. The rotten featherboard panels for the side wall have been replaced, old boards ready for burning
- 4. The rambling rose on wall next to car parking area needs trimming and tying up once flowering has finished.
- 5. Gardening jobs to get Jonathan on board to help out.
- 6. Jenny Wilkinson has had trouble with the boiler, Alex to check this.
- 7. Harvey suggests we have 2 steamers we can use, a stainless steel pressure vessel. Tuesday 25<sup>th</sup> May meeting to set this up, to video so it can be part of practical training in the future.
- 8. Patrick advises that he has lost keys to the apiary but they have no ID on them.

## 5. Treasurer's Update (Warwick)

- 1. £314 donations from Winter Course is less than last year, possibly caused by lack of personal touch as it has all been online this year.
- 2. BDI/capitation has been paid. Water readings required for Twickenham and Mole. Electricity £127 only this year.
- 3. Expenses £5050.78, income £8184.00. Open Day/Honey Show together are a big income generators which we have lost out on.
- 4. Accountant has the final figures, Patrick expects this in 2 weeks' time.

#### 7. AOB

- 1. COVID: Keeping up to date with the guidelines we could expand the size of the groups for the beginners.
- 2. Warwick suggests a case for online learning for general membership eg Friday. Ray suggests purchasing one license for cloud based video conferencing £120/year, 1GB of recording (aprox 2 hours) included in this. Any recordings can then be put on our Youtube channel. Ray proposes the go ahead to purchase, Harvey seconded. Motion passed with no objections.
- 3. With the passing of Margaret English, there are 3 trustees: Ted Chatley Neil Hilbury and Chris Deaves. Further trustees need to be appointed at next AGM or make the Association an incorporated charity, engage a solicitor and set up as a company which would hold the deeds of property etc. Warwick indicates that this could be a one year project and a presentation at the AGM would be pertinent. The BBKA became an incorporated charity last year. We would require a new constitution, register with the Charities Commission and change our "Raison D'Etre".
- 4. Margaret English passed away in 2018. She was a stalwart of the Association and her involvement spanned many many years. The beekeeping equipment room is named after her. Also Tony Enos passed away in 2020. He was instrumental in setting up microscopy at the Association.
- 5. Irek: 8 students are wanting to take the basic exam this year, 4-5 students can be accommodated per day. Ray has the list of students who have paid for the exam. 5 hives in Twickenham to be made available.
- 6. Harvey wants to know if it is possible to include a 13 year old in beginner beekeeping group. At present the groups are working under Covid guidelines and a parent would have to be a chaperone (safeguarding), Junior members usually join with a full adult member.
- 7. AGM date to be set once Covid restrictions are ended.
- 8. Date for diary: September 4<sup>th</sup> Molesey Eco-Fair. Jane to confirm once Covid restrictions
- 9. Mike Scotton has given up beekeeping and has an observation hive which may be useful to the Association. This would be a formal donation with his name on the hive.
- 10. Still having problems locating adrenaline auto injector (Epipen/Emerade) due to worldwide shortage.
- 11. Alex has performed a bleach deep clean in Miller Hall.
